

## LABORATORY STUDENT INJURY REPORTING PROCEDURES

**\*\*FOR A LIFE-THREATENING EMERGENCY, SEEK IMMEDIATE MEDICAL TREATMENT\*\***

**For assistance during a life-threatening emergency, please dial 404-413-3333.**

1. IMMEDIATELY report injury to Principal Investigator or Laboratory Supervisor.
2. Follow laboratory protocol for immediate first aid utilizing the Critical Event Guide.
3. The Principal Investigator or Laboratory Supervisor must report all laboratory injuries to the Department of Safety & Risk Management within 24 hours. The Laboratory Accident Report form is available online at:
